Prayer

Ephesians 6:18

Pray at all times as the Holy Spirit leads you to pray. Pray on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests.

Dice Prayers: (**You will need: A dice.** If you don't have a dice, use pieces of paper and a 'hat')

Take turns rolling the dice and pray according to the numbers that you throw:

- Thank God for something in your life.
- Praise God for someone in your life.
- Pray for something that you need.
- Pray for someone you know who is in need.
- Pray for your neighbours / local community.
- Pray for needs of the wider world.

Ask God to lead you in your prayer time through his Holy Spirit, and help you to think of things to pray for in line with His goodness.

Questions to ponder this week ...

1. "God doesn't coerce or force us to change our behaviour, but confronts us with the choice of changing" (Sister Margaret Magdalen). How do you judge / make considered decisions? Not just on the big things in life, but also every day choices?
2. What things in the news this week have you found offensive? Read Galatians 5:19-23. What aspects of these lists are most reported in the media? What should our response to these things be? Why?
