Pentecost Crafts



1. Cut paper into long strips, to form a headband.
 2. Decorate the paper with pens, stickers, and/or bible verses.
 3. Measure the headband to fit around wearer's head, then staple or stick together.
 4. Create a "flame" by cutting and gluing paper together. (there is a template on one of the other sheets)
- Attach the "flame" to the headband and you are done!



Flame hat and pinwheel



1. Make sure the paper is square in shape. Colour or decorate as desired.
2. Draw lines from each corner through the middle.
3. Carefully cut along the lines from the corners of the paper to almost the centre, stopping just short of the middle to avoid cutting all the way through the paper.
4. Starting with one corner, carefully pull every other "point" of the paper down to the centre of the paper. Hold the paper together.
5. Fasten all the points together going through the middle with a split pin, staple, or glue.
6. Attach to a stick, straw or pencil to complete your pinwheel.
