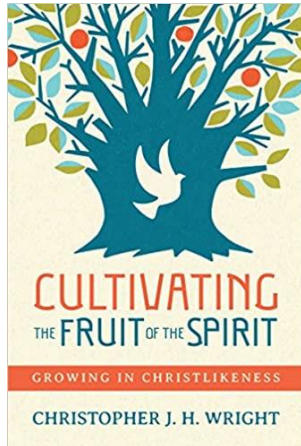
## Benediction
